Kent artist, Andy Touhy's exhibition opened at the Margate Gallery <http://www.margategallery.co.uk/> in June and continues through to 22 July. Andy produces exquisite retro inspired work of iconic architecture and locations including beautiful prints of Dreamland's Grade II* listed cinema building and the Grade II* Scenic Railway.

With the holiday season almost upon us there is plenty more to look forward to and The Dreamland Trust is delighted to be involved in some of the exciting events and activities happening in and around Margate over the next couple of months.

Kent's Cultural Baton, part of the 2012 Cultural Olympiad, continues its tour around the county. On the weekend of 13-16 July we are celebrating the arrival of the Boat Project in Margate with free singing, dancing, films, processions, live music and more in and around Margate's harbour area, old town and seafront. *Angels by Day - Spirits by Night* is a living archive of people's stories and lives, a 30ft seafaring vessel made from donated wooden items, as part of the London 2012 Cultural Olympiad festival. HAPPY BIRTHDAY THE SCENIC RAILWAY!

Dreamland's Scenic Railway is 92 years old this July and forms part of the Dreamland's collection of heritage structures including 'Lord' George Sanger's Grade II listed menagerie cages and the cinema building.

The Scenic Railway opened to the public in 1920 carrying half a million passengers in just 13 weeks! This popular ride was described by its patent thus:

"Each car will travel along the straight portions of the track and acquire a quick centrifugal motion in passing around the curves, turns or corners, the suddenness of which causes agitation or commotion of the occupants, and hence much merriment and amusement!"

An arson attack destroyed 25% of the ride in 2008, including the station and original trains, but with money secured from the Heritage Lottery Fund, The Dreamland Trust, in partnership with Thanet District Council, are working towards restoring this internationally important thrilling ride to its former working glory. We look forward to many happy returns!
